Enrollment Information

- CAVIT is a public high school offering career and technical education training in high-wage, high-demand careers.
- There are no fees to attend CAVIT for high school students.
- Current sophomores, juniors, seniors, and graduates up to the age of 20 residing within CAVIT's boundary are eligible to apply.
- CAVIT serves students from 12 Pinal County high schools, in addition, to online and home school participants.
- CAVIT registrations for 2022-2023 will be taken during Letter of Intent Nights scheduled from January 25 - February 10.
- Priority is given to applications submitted by March 1.
- Names of applicants will be forwarded to schools who determine eligibility to attend CAVIT.
- Acceptance letters will be mailed out to students by March 15.
- Students participating in high school sponsored events will be excused from attending CAVIT on those days.
- Each high school that partners with CAVIT provides daily transportation to the Coolidge central campus.
- Adult students new to attending CAVIT will be charged the \$2,800 yearly tuition fee.
- CAVIT provides two sets of uniforms at no cost. Students wear their uniforms daily to CAVIT as part of the dress code requirement. Students must arrive at CAVIT dressed in their uniform.
- CAVIT awards a certificate of completion to second year students who successfully complete all requirements.
- CAVIT and high schools calendars do not align. Students are required to attend CAVIT during high school breaks, intersessions, and early release days.
- CAVIT provides accommodations and modifications identified in the IEP/504 for students who are concurrently enrolled in high school. Students who graduated from high school or have a GED will not be eligible for these services. The student will need to self-advocate for reasonable accommodations that are aligned to industry certifications.

Grading and Credits Earned

- Grading Scale - 90-100%=A, 80-89%=B, 70-79%=C, 69% and Below=F.
- CAVIT does not award credit for a D or F grade.
- CAVIT issues one elective credit per semester.
- Students successfully completing a CAVIT program have the opportunity to earn free dual enrollment college credit providing the program is eligible and all requirements are met.
- An industry credential is offered within each program to students successfully passing all requirements.
